TRUCK AND TRAILER INSPECTION

- 1. Bumper
- 2. Engine
- 3. Tires (truck and trailer)
- 4. Floor (inside the truck)
- 5. Fuel tanks
- 6. Cab/storage compartments
- 7. Air tanks
- 8. Drive shafts
- 9. Fifth wheel

- 10. Outside/ undercarriage
- 11. Outside/inside doors
- 12. Floor (inside trailer)
- 13. Side walls
- 14. Front wall
- 15. Ceiling/Roof
- 16. Refrigeration Unit
- 17. Exhaust

TIP!

Begin and end your inspection at the same point every time!



TRAILER SEAL INSPECTION

Seal Verification and Inspection Process:









View seal and container locking hardware Verify seal number

Tug on seal to make sure it's on properly

Twist and turn seal to make sure it doesn't unscrew

Must use PAS ISO 17712 bolt seal on US bound trailers
