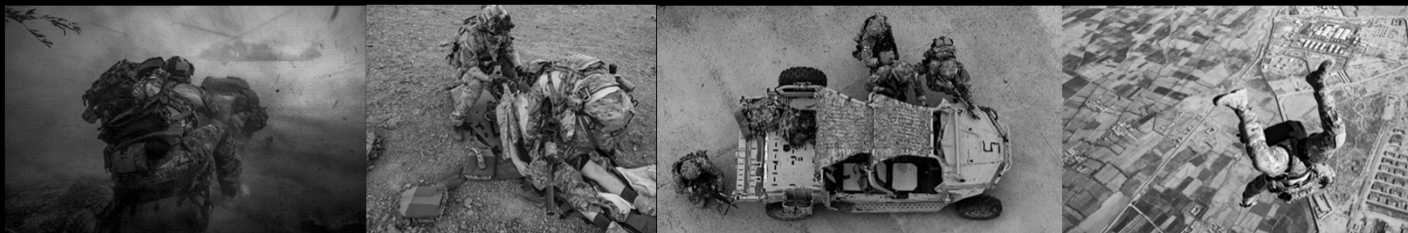

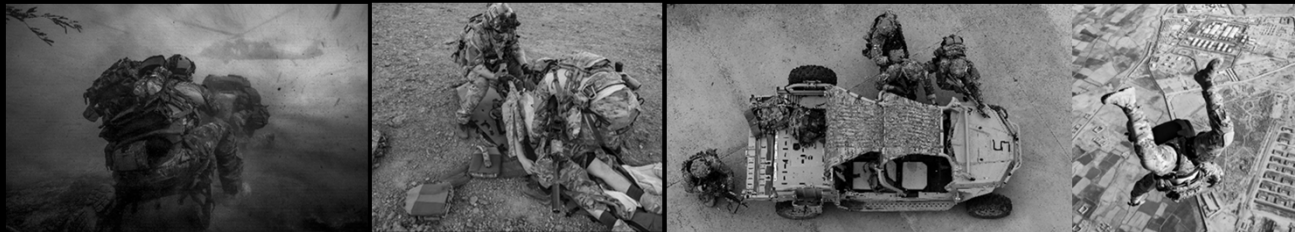

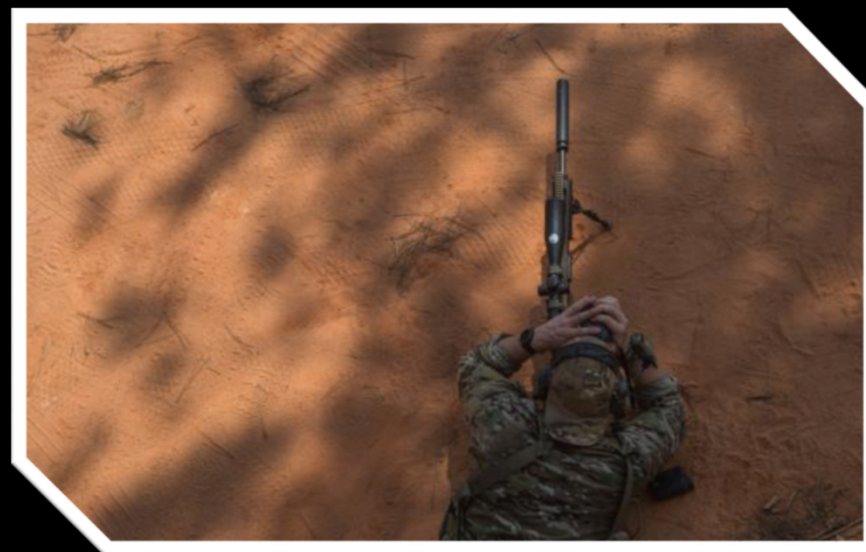

Scout - Recruit – Develop

Approximately 4-6 months

Engage with a local Special Warfare Recruiter (SWR)

Begin 21 Days to Pass the PAST workout program
Educate on SW components, mission, specialties

Educate on SWOE vectoring process
Conduct pre-accessions development

Pass Physical Assessment (PAST)
Compete for selection
Receive developer recommendation
Contract and ship as SWOE candidate



Basic Military Training

8 weeks w/ SW flights

Special Warfare Prep Course

8 weeks

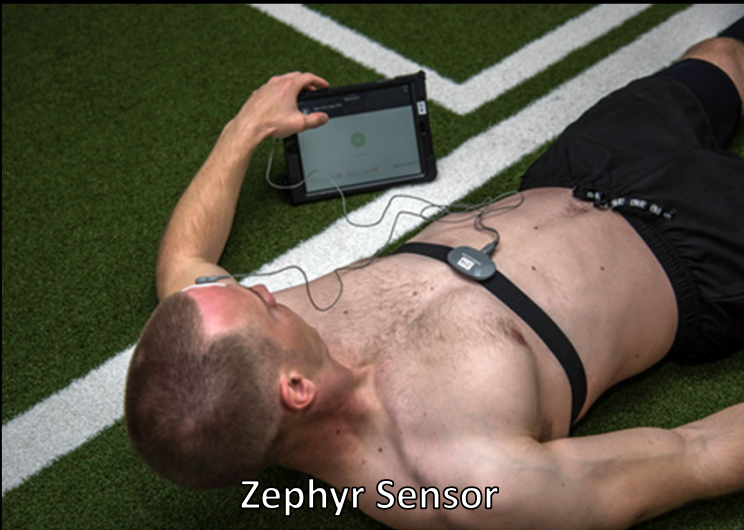
