Applying to College with Apply Texas

Go to www.applytexas.org and create an account using a PERSONAL EMAIL that you have easy access to. You will have to verify your email each time you log in via an email from Microsoft on Behalf of THECB. (wait up to 5 minutes for the verification and check your spam/junk folder; do not click send new code, it will delay the process)

PRO TIP: Do not change your email address in the middle of the college application process.

STEP 1: Select "Find the Right Application"

- Currently in High School- Select Yes
- Type of Program you plan to apply to- ALL SENIORS SELECT: Undergraduate
- Have you ever taken college courses? Only select Yes if you have been in Dual Credit or ECHS. Do not select
 Yes for AP courses. (if you select yes, you will answer "I am in high school/none of the above apply to me on
 next question)
- All seniors select: UNDERGRADUATE
- Are you a U.S. citizen? Answer Yes or No (if you answer No, see Eagles College Center for assistance to ensure your application is submitted correctly)
- The next page should show you that you are eligible to apply for Undergraduate, 2 year colleges & 4 year colleges.

STEP 2: "Core Questions"

 Select "Start Core Questions"- You will only have to answer the core questions one time, your answers will be applied to all of your college applications. Make sure to answer everything correctly & call your parents if you need to!

PRO TIPS FOR ANSWERING CORE QUESTIONS:

- Select YES to use your Apply Texas email address on college applications
- Designating someone to discuss your application means that you can add someone's name to give them permission to speak to admissions about your application, such as your parent. You can select yes or no, it's up to you.
- If you have a SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER, you <u>MUST</u> include it! It helps match your application to multiple college departments (admissions & financial aid) If you do not know your SSN, see Eagles College Center. If you do not have an SSN, skip this question.
- ALL SENIORS- yes, you are currently residing in the U.S.
- Military Status- N/A
- Answer the gross income guestion- it can be used to determine fee waiver eligibility
- TEXAS RESIDENCY SECTION- you may need to contact your parent to complete this section
- Are you claimed as a dependent... Select YES, the rest of the page is about your parent(s)
- Expected Graduation Date: 05/22/2024
- Senior Courses- add each course in your senior schedule (you do not need to add off periods)
- Do you have a GED- No
- Dual Credit & ECHS students- Select yes for previous college courses, use your San Jac SOS/GPS to find your total current hours earned
- Future College Plans- ALL SENIORS SELECT- High School Diploma, first time in college
- Pasadena High School's School Day SAT date was: 03/06/2024
- ACTIVITIES & ACHIEVEMENTS- take your time and list everything in all 4 years of high school
- UIL activities are State level

- Answer all required questions and essays and submit

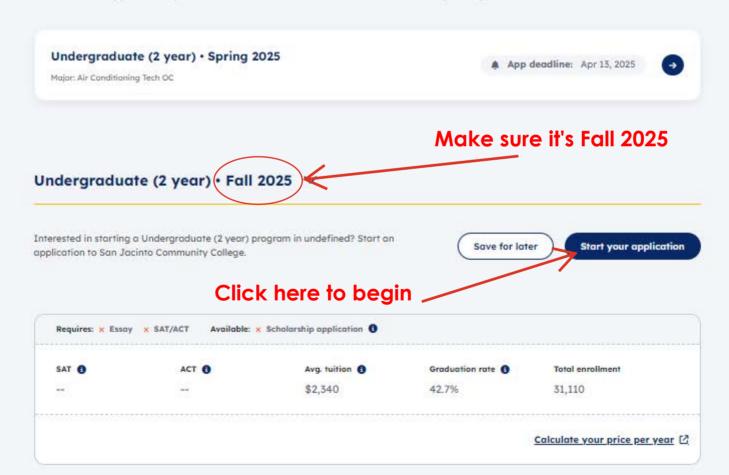

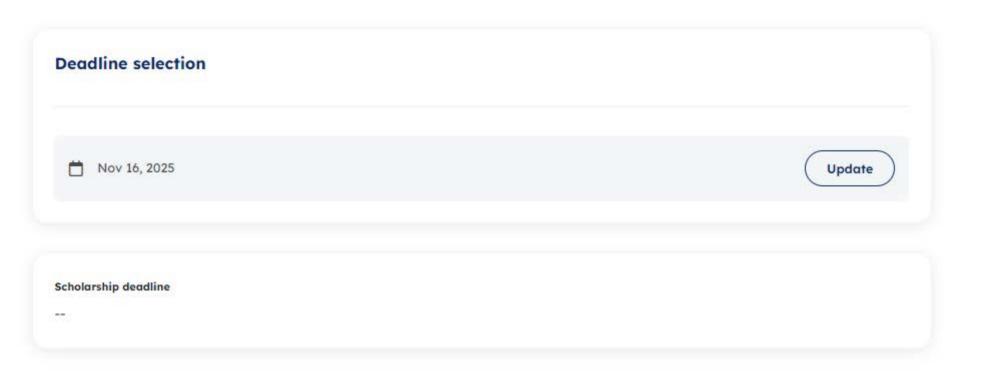

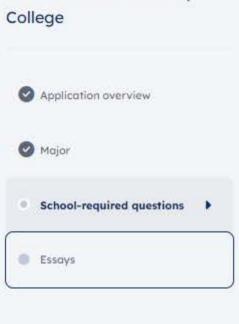
