Egypt, Assyria, Babylon, Persia, Greece, and Rome had all successively proven that "the world through its wisdom did not know God" (1 Corinthians 1:21). Even with all their mighty conquerors, poets, historians, architects, and philosophers, the kingdoms of the world were full of dark idolatry. It was, indeed, "due time" for God to interpose from heaven and send down an almighty Savior. It was "due time" for Christ to be born (Romans 5:6).

5 compelling pieces of evidence that support the divine life of Jesus Christ - Washington Times

Recently, I caught up with <u>Jim Warner Wallace</u>, a former cold-case detective and renowned Christian case-maker, to gain insight into the enduring appeal of <u>Jesus</u> by utilizing some of his investigative skills to explore the historical and scientific evidence for the existence and divinity of <u>Jesus</u>.

1. The Credibility of the Canonical Gospels

The four gospels (Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John) provide primary sources for understanding Jesus' life and teachings. The texts were written by eyewitnesses or people who had access to eyewitness accounts, offering detailed depictions of Jesus' life, including His crucifixion and resurrection. Centuries of scrutiny by scholars support the historical accuracy of the gospels, making them a valuable historical foundation for the Christian faith and providing compelling evidence of Jesus' existence.

By the fourth century, the bishop of Caesarea and great church historian Eusebius (A.D. 270-340) articulated the canon of most of the 27 books in his "Church History." However, it was <u>Athanasius</u> (bishop of Alexandria) who wrote in "Festal Letter" (A.D. 367), the 27 canonical books that make up the New Testament today. By the time of the Synod of Hippo (A.D. 393) Council of Carthage (A.D. 397), the council decreed the 27 books as Divine Scripture that encapsulates the pure image and teachings of <u>Jesus Christ</u> as the Son of God, the Savior of the world.

2. Extra-Biblical Sources

Beyond the canonical gospels, numerous extra-biblical sources from various ancient historians provide additional validation for <u>Jesus</u> existence. Tacitus, a Roman historian writing in the early part of the second century A.D., mentions Christ in his work "Annals," affirming his crucifixion under Pontius Pilate. Furthermore, Jewish historian Flavius Josephus refers to <u>Jesus</u> in his writings "Antiquities" and "The Jewish War," confirming His impact on society and the rise of Christianity.

3. Non-Judeo-Christian Sources

Even non-Judeo-Christian sources acknowledge <u>Jesus</u> influence and role in history. The Roman historian Suetonius mentions disturbances within Rome due to Chrestus (Christ), highlighting early Christian presence during Emperor Claudius's reign. In his exceptional book, "<u>Person of Interest: Why Jesus Still Matters in a World that Rejects the Bible</u>," Mr. <u>Wallace</u> provides an in-depth analysis of several non-Christian sources that reference various aspects of <u>Jesus</u> 'life and ministry in Nazareth.

4. Archaeological Discoveries

Archaeologists have discovered artifacts corresponding to events described in the gospels, lending credibility to their historical accuracy. Notable findings, such as the Pontius Pilate inscription at Caesarea Maritima and the Caiaphas Ossuary, offer physical evidence of significant figures present during <u>Jesus</u> 'crucifixion.

5. Christianity as a Copycat Religion

The belief that Christianity copied stories from pagan religions, also known as the "Copycat Christianity" or "mythicist" position, has been widely discredited since the mid-20th century. The academic community has largely rejected this idea since there is a lack of substantial evidence to support it. The similarities found between different religious traditions are often due to shared human experiences and universal themes, rather than a direct correlation between Christianity and other mythological stories.

For instance, some skeptics argue that the story of <u>Jesus</u> was borrowed from earlier mythological figures, such as Horus or Mithras. However, the idea of a unified religion is misinformed and misrepresents the Gospel records. The early Christian writers did not have access to any pre-Christian doctrine of rebirth to borrow from. Jewish Christians would not have compromised their beliefs by blending them with other syncretic religions. Unlike other Gentile religions, Judaism was not inclusive. It is crucial to examine the evidence from both the canonical gospels and extra-biblical sources to understand the credibility of <u>Jesus Christ</u>'s life.

Furthermore, Mr. <u>Wallace</u> and I <u>discussed</u> how the timing of the canonical gospels and the accounts of <u>Jesus</u> 'life predate other supposed parallels. The gospels were written within decades of <u>Jesus</u> 'life, while the supposed parallels from other religions emerged much later. Mr. <u>Wallace</u> further pointed out that the parallels between <u>Jesus</u> and these mythological figures are often exaggerated or outright fabricated.

The bottom line is the historical evidence firmly establishes that <u>Jesus</u>' life and teachings were unique and distinct from any other religious figure. If someone challenges the credibility of <u>Jesus</u> and the Christian faith, take a firm stance and provide them with evidence of the historical existence of <u>Jesus</u> <u>Christ</u>. It's equally important to emphasize the profound significance of His death, burial, and resurrection, which offers us a new life in Him. Communicating this message can help others understand the truth about <u>Jesus</u> and His lasting impact on the world.

Two Wives: Peninnah and Hannah One had kids... one didn't No Kids – Elkhannah loved Vrs 5... because he loved her

Sounds like Abraham: Hagar and Sarah and Jacob: Leah and Rachel story

Elkhannah go to Shiloh frequently to sacrifice to the Lord

Gave Hannah 2x portion for sacrifice as they would go to Tabernacle Vrs 5... but to Hannah he gave a double portion

Elkhannah loved Hannah Brought her to the Lord with him... Encouraged Personal Worship Addressed Her concerns

Asked about her feelings He paid attention to her!

Definition of Courage

n the Face of Fear

Courage: Is it an Action? A Place of Being? A Position of the Heart

Courage is Obedience to the Spirit that stems from knowledge and confidence of Christ who empowers you act, react, persist in the face of fear

Courage is obedience to the Lord in the Face of Fear!

Not just belief... it is faith in Action, Reaction and sometimes Resistance

We need faith to be Obedience... in order to be courageous, we need obedience...

Even the demons believe.... The Difference is Evil leverages their believe for rebellion...

Important Note: The closer you get the Spirit... The Closer Evil will get to you... its like the Eye of Sauron...

The Closer Evil evil gets to you, the more courage you will need....

Evil is growing in our world today... its not b/c evil is more confident... I believe evil is growing b/c its more concerned...

Evil knows its time is limited.... M8.28,29 what have you to do w/ us 'O Son of God'; have you come to torment us before the appointed time

Courage is not automatic... as our relationship & confidence in who the Spirit is grows closer; our courage grows louder & evil cowars
