MOTHER ABANDONED THE CHILD FOR A LONG PERIOD OF TIME

BUT CALLED THE FATHER "A DANGER TO WOMEN AND CHILDREN" (5) FATHER EXCEEDED AMOUNT OF VISITATION TIME TO MOTHER (6) MOTHER HAS HAD NO CONTACT (PHONE) WITH CHILD BY PHONE (7)

(8) FATHER ATTEMPTED TO CONTINUE CHILD'S CONTACT WITH MATERNAL FAMILY, BUT THAT WAS A FAILURE

(9) THIS CASE APPEARS TO BE A CASE WHERE SHOULD BE PERMANENT OR INTERIM CUSTODY OF PARENTS & RIGHTS REVERSED THAT TO INCREASE MOTHER CONTACT W/ CHILD

(10) AS RELOCATION HAS BEEN ALLOWED BY COURT BY PRIOR ORDER, AND OBJECTION WITHDRAWN BY MOTHER, THERE IS NO STATUTORY AUTHORITY FOR MODIFICATION (11) FATHER IS AWARDED

\$2,000 ATTORNEYS FEES BY SEPARATE JUDGMENT.

(12) GAL MAY BRING MOTION FOR PAYMENT OF OUTSTANDING FEES (WITH ACKNOWLEDGMENT BY THE COURT THAT GAL ONLY CONTACTED 1 OUT OF SIX OF FATHER'S COLLATERALS); (13) FATHER MAY REQUEST ADDITIONAL ATTORNEYS FEES UPON PROVISION OF AN ATTORNEY'S FEE DECLARATION. (14) GAL IS DISCHARGED.

(15) Evidence would more likely support a decrease in visitation than a major modification increasing it.

(16) Moving party failed to submit moving working papers and the reply papers were late and incomplete. This point only goes to issue of atty fees


