The Support You Need

The Renaissance Residential Program offers a wide range of **supportive services** to youth in residence that are tailored to their individual goals and needs.

Services Include:

Therapeutic and trauma-informed residential care, providing a safe and nurturing environment for healing and growth.

Intensive mental health counseling with a licensed therapist is available to help youth address and overcome any emotional or psychological challenges they may be facing.

Case management services are provided to ensure that each youth has a personalized plan and access to resources that will support their long-term success.

Independent living skills development is also offered, equipping youth with the necessary skills to live independently and successfully transition into adulthood.

Around-the-Clock Care

Integrated Non-Public School: Renaissance Community Prep

Renaissance Community Prep is a non-public school **certified by the California Department of Education** to serve students ages 5-22.

Situated within the serene, park-like grounds of our partner campus, the school offers a calm, nurturing, and structured environment designed to meet the **individual needs of students** based on their Individual Education Plan (IEP).

Classes are constructed by **credentialed special education teachers** to provide a beneficial environment where students can develop academic, social, behavioral, and vocational skills that will enable them to transition successfully into mainstream work, school, and/or independent living.

- Clerical

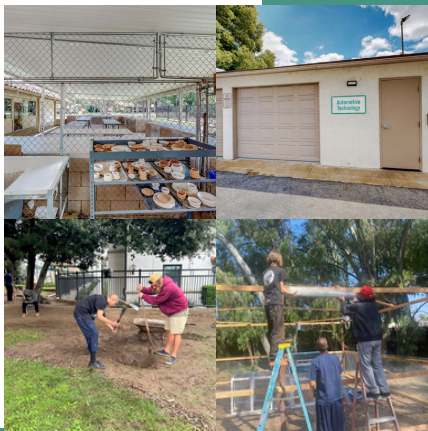


Vocational Arts

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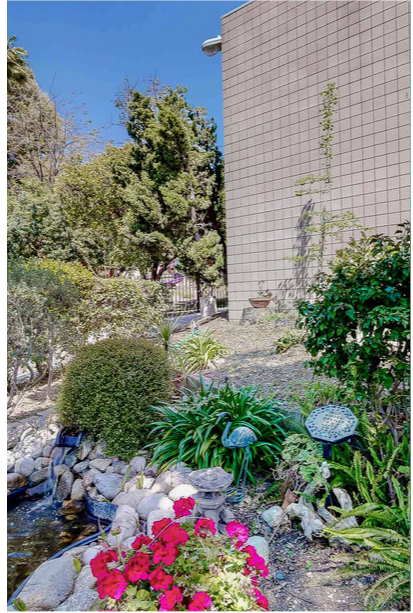
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
