

CHECK IN

As noted above we will send the Access Code on the day of your arrival. Check In Time starts at 4:00PM. Please do NOT arrive at the property early unless management has approved an early Check In, as it puts undue pressure on our cleaners and sanitization team and may delay your access.

If our cleaning and sanitation team finishes early, we will always let you know as soon as the home is available.

To access the house, press home button, your personal code and front door will unlock. To lock the door from outside just tap the lock icon. You can also lock your door from inside by turning the thumbturn towards the door edge.

Once inside we recommend you take a few minutes to familiarize yourself with the house. The master bedroom, bedroom 2 and the laundry room are located on the Main floor. Bedroom 3 and 4 on lower level. Stairs are on the right side, right after dining table.

INDOORS



TVS

Currently every room has a Smart TV with cable TV (except for 2nd bedroom upstairs and garage, but you still have a selection of wireless channels and can use your own Netflix, Hulu, Disney Channel password).

CHARGING STATIONS

There is a phone and tablet Charging Station located in the kitchen and downstairs in the Family Room.

COFFEE BAR

We have created a Coffee Bar that hopefully every coffee drinker will love. Please enjoy as there is a large pot, single serve K Cups, ground coffee, whole beans, French Press, and a variety of options to drink, from Espresso to Hot Chocolate and Teas.

FIREPLACES

We have 2 fireplaces inside the house. The one in the living room is gas. Just turn the remote to on and it will light up. The one on the upper porch is log only. Please insert 2-3 pieces of log and one a starter block. Allow around 15 minutes for the fire to pick up. Please no foreign objects in the fireplaces. Nothing should be placed or burned inside the fireplace.

OWNER'S CLOSET

The closet in garage is locked and only accessible by the owners and cleaners.

INDOORS



KITCHEN SINK

The property is on septic tank, therefore, no food or solids are permitted down the drain of the kitchen sink. There is a small trash located in the cabinet under the sink for easy access to scrape plates.

SMALL APPLIANCES

Most common used small appliances are on the corner cabinet, near the sink. There you can find blender,

toaster and rice maker.

BASIC SEASONINGS

Above the small appliance cabinet, you can find some

basic seasonings and cooking oil

PANTRY

There is a large walk-in pantry adjacent to the adjacent

to the kitchen, so you have plenty of storage that also contains some other small appliances, such as extra coffee maker, toaster, and crockpot. All BBQ accessories can be found in the drawers.

DOORS

Please keep the doors always closed, so the house does not get filled with mosquitoes and bugs. The upper porch, master bedroom sunroom and lower porch doors are multi-point lock doors. To open the door, grasp the handle and push down, then operate the door. To engage the multipoint lock, close the door and lift the handle and turn to lock position.

OUTDOORS



SPIDERS/SPIDER WEBS

Spiders are an important part of the ecosystem surrounding the house and you might see a lot of them in the outdoors. Most spiders are harmless, and some are not. Be careful, but please do not kill them.

BEARS

Occasionally you might see bears in the community. Please do not leave food unattended outside the house, burn food particles on BBQ grill after using and close the lid. Make sure all garbage is bagged and thrown in the bear proof bin outside the house.

SECURITY CAMERAS

For your security, there are cameras around the exterior of the property, pointing to to driveway, side door and staircase that leads to backyard.

BBQ

Our brand-new BBQ grill is fueled by gas. Please keep an eye on the BBQ at all times once you have ignited it. Please clean the grill to avoid attracting wild animals.

OUTDOORS



FIRE PIT

You will need to bring your own firewood to build your fire. Be sure the fire is put out before you leave the fire for the night. There is an iron fire pit poker on the upper deck wood fireplace to help you move wood around the pit. No trash is to be put into the fire pit. The Adirondack chairs are NOT to be removed from the firepit area.

FIRE EXTINGUISHER

There are 2 fire extinguishers in the house: one hanging at the upper porch and the other one under the stove, inside the cabinet.

HOT TUB

The Hot tub has a preset temperature of 98oF. Please shower to remove all lotion, sunblock before going into the hot tub. Do not leave kids unattended. Close the hot tub after use, to make sure no bugs or leaves fall in and to keep the temperature.

TRASH

Before check out, please place all trash bagged inside the bear proof garbage can located outside the garage.



HOUSE RULES

- 1. No smoking, vaping, drugs, or underage drinking is permitted anywhere on property. If your guests smoke inside the house, you will be charged a \$750.00 Ozone cleaning fee.
- 2. Only small dogs (under 30lbs) are considered. It has to be listed in your reservation and a pet fee needs to be paid. We do not supply pet beddings. If you bring a non authorized pet, you will be charged \$500.00 and an additional \$250.00 ozone and cleaning fee.
 - 3. No wet towels or clothing on the furniture or hardwood flooring.
 - 4. No parties. If you host a party with unregistered guests, you will be charged \$100 per guest, a \$600 additional cleaning fee, and will be evicted immediately.
- 5. Maximum number of guests is 10. Additional guests not on the list will be charged to the guest responsible for the reservation at a rate of \$100 per person per night.
- 6. You are responsible for all equipment, games, appliances if used. Be sure to follow the instructions and use them accordingly.
- 7. Quiet Time is from 10:00pm to 8:00am. This means no outside music and noise must be kept to a minimum as voices carry across the mountain.
- 8. Toilet paper is the ONLY thing to be flushed down the toilet. If other items are flushed and clog the septic system, a \$350 damage fee will be charged.
 - 9. No food or waste to be flush down the kitchen sink drain. Please remove excess of grease before loading dish or pan to the dishwasher.

11. Do not use the white towels to remove makeup. We provide makeup towels for this, as your makeup will stain the towels and then we will have to charge you \$35.00 per towel.



12. Please make sure all the doors, screened doors, and windows are closed at all times, as to avoid insects or animals looking for food. If using the outdoor grill, be sure to burn off all residues of food and scrape the grill to avoid attracting wild animals such as bears and wild dogs. DO NOT leave food outdoors when no one is around. Keep exterior doors closed, even if you are in there.

- 13. No firewood in the Living Room gas burning fireplace. No candles in the house.
- 14. For your safety, DO NOT leave fireplace burning overnight. No burning of anything besides log in the Porch's fireplace and no foreign objects inside the living room fireplace.
- 15. Tampering of smoke and CO2 detector or cameras will result in a fine of \$250 and guests will be asked to leave.

16. No kids unattended inside the hot tub. Please shower and remove all lotions and sunblock before entering hot tub. NO BUBBLES in the hot tub. It could cause system to clog and you'll be responsible for repair costs. Please make sure you close the hot tub after use, in order to keep it at optimal temperature. When using the hot tub, the cover should be gently place on the rack, NOT on the floor. No sitting, standing or jumping on the cover. If damaged, guest will be responsible for replacement costs.

17. No AC lower than 67oF, as low temperatures will freeze up the pipes resulting in shutting off the water supply.

18. Prior to check out please load and start the dishwasher, bag all the garbage and place it in the black bear-proof garbage bin on the driveway and be sure all entry/exit doors to the house are locked. Please make sure gas fireplace in living room is turned off and porch fireplace does not have a burning log. Leave towels on bathroom floor and beds unmade.



Check out instructions

Your checkout time is 10:00 am.

1. Leave the laundry to us! Bed as-is and towels on the bathroom floor.

2. Empty leftover food items into the trash.

3. Please load all dishes into the dishwasher and press start (Please make sure to wipe the excess of grease before loading into the dishwasher, as it could clog the dishwasher and our septic tank).

4. Please remove all items from the fridge and bag it before placing the

trash in the bear proof receptacle outside the house. If outside garbage can is full, please leave it in the kitchen garbage can. The non-bear proof garbage can is only for clean cardboards.

5. Make sure all door and windows are locked, AC/heater, gas fireplace, TVs and lights are turned off.

6. Have a safe drive home and come back and see us again!
