IS THE MGC FOR ME?

If you feel called to long term missions work, then yes! The MGC is for you! Our purpose will be to help get you from short-term to long-term in the field of your calling.

IS THE MGC FOR FAMILIES?

Absolutely! Our focus is helping families transition from the States to long-term missions in the CAC Region and beyond.

IS IT SAFE FOR ME/MY FAMILY?

The D.R. is a fairly safe place that can be navigated with minimal restrictions even for families. There is currently no political unrest or war in the D.R. However, the D.R. is considered a 3rd world country.

This means we learn to take certain precautions while in the country. This is the case for many of the nations in the CAC region. Therefore it is a great place to prepare for life on the missions field.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

Each individual and family will have a customized budget for their time on the field. The budget will be for basic living and transportation expenses. For first time AIMers, there is a \$100 application fee at HQ.

WHEN & FOR HOW LONG?

There is a minimum of 2 months required to go on AIM. However, each missionary journey will look different and their time on the field will look different. You can stay for 2, 3, 6 months, or longer depending on your situation. Remember the goal is to get planted in a country in need. If your budget allows, you could go directly to another country from the MGC.

WHERE WOULD I STAY?

There are many homes and apartments available through AirBNB. We help coordinate good options for your family size and budget.

WHAT KIND OF TRAINING WOULD I RECEIVE?

Hands on! There are many churches in need of helping hands. We want you to use your gifting and calling in the local churches.

Classes would be seminar style to cover missionary specific material. This is not a bible school. You would also be enrolled in language study.

WHAT KIND OF SUPPORT WOULD I GET?

One great benefit of coming to the MGC first is, you become a part of the MGC family. We are here to help you get planted on the field and we will be an advocate for you throughout your missions journey. You will receive support from our team that insures you can thrive in place of your calling.

CAN I COME FOR A VISIT FIRST?

Absolutely! If you would like to schedule a scouting trip and come solo or with your family, we can make that happen. You can come for 1-2 weeks and get a feel for the area and work before committing to come for an extended period of time.

IS THERE HEALTH INSURANCE AVAILABLE?

Health insurance can be purchased for the duration of your time on the field. More information can be obtained through the Short-Term Missions office.
