Q: What does my entry ticket include?

A: Ticket includes entry into the Deering Estate for the Seafood Festival. You may purchase your choice of food and beverage from participating restaurants upon entry. Please also note that you will need a wristband to consume alcoholic beverages. Our helpers provide the wristbands outside the gate, inside the gate and also inside at our INFO BOOTH.

Q: How can I become a Deering Estate member?

Q: Are the Historic House Museums open?

A: For the protection of the Historic House Museums they are closed during the event. Visit us again during normal operating hours from 10:00 AM to 5:00 PM for self guided touring.

Q: What items/activities are prohibited on-site?

A: Please bring no tents/canopies, in-ground umbrellas, coolers, fishing equipment, and swimming gear on-site. Additionally, alcoholic beverages, cigarettes, drones, balloons, balls, BBQs/barbecues/grills, bicycles, confetti, candles/flames, glitter, frisbees, fireworks, hammocks, kites, remote-control boats/cars, rollerblades/skates, scooters, skateboards, and pets (including emotional support animals, therapy animals, and comfort animals) are not permitted on the estate.
