Comes now, James Christianson, Petitioner, pro se and submits this diary. Below are my first hand eye witness accounts and summaries of events that occurred, which are relevant to this case. The events described did occur on the days and times designated as the heading of each section. I wrote the accounts below on the same day of the events. This is my original copy of my "diary" or accounts of said events, as I typed them directly herein on the said days.

Tuesday, September 10, 2001

Had a picnic/BBQ at the Williams' home. Grandpa was in town and meet daughter for the first time. She warmed up to him and wouldn't let go when he handed her back to me. Loves grandpa. See picture from that day of me bottle feeding her. **Pic #0001**. Mother refused to pump breast milk so I made formula with coconut water and other fruits from Yahki recipe.

Friday, September 13, 2001

Visitation exchange at my apartment manager's office. Normal handoff where I hand her to the mom in her snap-out car seat (we both have the same base). Made sure I was waiting in front of the manager's door so they can see us (witnesss). I placed her on ground and backed

1 up so mom could pick her up and I said "bye" and mom looked back at me in disgust. Then I
2 waived to daughter and saw her catch my eye. Mom was getting in car on the other side of me
3 and flipped me off. Didn't take picture.

4 **Monday, September 17, 2001**

5 Gave her a bath without her crying. She splashed and played and enjoyed the beach ball. Pic
6 #0002

7 **Thursday September 28, 2002**

8 Went to the Johnson's house on Mirror Lake. Daughter loved the slide, played with their
9 daughter Angel (same age) much of the time and we went on the lake in a small paddle boat
10 and she loved it. Pic #0003

11 **Sunday, November 11, 2002**

12 After breakfast she saw me doing the dishes and wanted to help. Pic #0004. We did chores
13 all day, then went to ice cream parlor at Lake Forest around 6:00 PM and I told her I was
14 proud of her wanting to help and her face lit up. Then we played the full size chess game in
15 that play area with pieces that are 2 feet tall. While playing, she said, "Dad, I want to see you
16 more."

17 **Monday, May 27, 2003 (Memorial Day) – Amusement Park & Farmers' Market**

18 I took daughter to a traveling amusement park. They were at SeaTac Mall all weekend. She
19 had a blast and didn't want to leave. See pic #0005 of us on the potato sack slide.

20 We got there at a few minutes after noon and stayed until 3:30. There was also a farmer's
21 market in the mall parking lot and we walked through the different stands. I counted about 20
22 of them. There were flowers and gardeners with plants and a BBQ pit from KC Deez. We got
23 some fresh strawberries and blueberries. I told her how important it was to get organic and
24 local fruit and how important fruit is to keep her body healthy. She said "antioxidants" perfectly
25 the first time I mentioned the word and asked her to repeat it.

That night was the first night she wanted to do a bath on her own. I let her do it with the door
half way open and me right outside on the living room couch. Every 3 minutes I hollered, "Are
you done?" and she said "no" several times till it was almost bedtime, around 8:30 pm. So, I
went in there and told her she did a good job but helped her wash up to make sure she didn't
miss anything and washed her hair and rinsed with the shower head. At bedtime she told me
she wish she could see me more.

1 **Friday, June 1, 2003 – Walmart Formal Pic**

2 Got pics taken at WalMart. **Pic #0006** is my favorite

3 **Tuesday, August 1, 2003 – Brand New Playhouse**

4 Got her a new playhouse. See **Pic #0007**. She immediately said, "I wanna have Amy come
5 over and play!" (her best friend)

6 **Saturday, September 6, 2003 – Hang out with William Gig Harbor lake house**

7 Hung out with the Williams family at their waterfront time share. Daughter played in water,
8 went on a boat ride and played with their kids. **Pic #0008** with Aunt Michelle.

9 **Friday, April 17, 2004 – Auburn Mall play area**

10 Went to Auburn Mall. Played in play area and went on merry go round. **Pic #0009**. When I
11 read her favorite Cinderella book before bed, she said she wanted to live with me. I said
12 "Why". She said "It's safe here." I asked "why" again and she said "Mommy's friend is scary
and mean." **Pic #0010**.

13 **Sunday, June 6, 2004 – Plaited braids**

14 Daughter said she wanted plaited braids like Amy has. So I did her hair and finally did it right
15 and had nice clean parts and tight braids. **Pics #0011 - #0012**

16 **Saturday, July 7, 2004 – Birthday Party Family Fun Center**

17 Had her birthday party 2 days after her birthday at Family Fun Center. **Pic #0013**. Had 9 of
18 her friends come. We were there from 1 pm until 7 pm, a little after the last guest, Robert left.
19 Went on nearly every ride and had the most fun shooting basketball and the frog hop and
outdoor bumper cars. When we got in car, she said, "Daddy, that was the best birthday ever!"

20 **Thursday, July 10, 2004 – Hawaii trip Day #1 – Luau**

21 First day in Honolulu. Went to a Luau tonight. **Pic #0014**. She loved the dancers and
22 entertainment and had a great time and commented how awesome it was to have all her
23 aunties and grandma and grandpa there.

24 **Friday, July 11, 2004 – Hawaii trip Day #2 – Surfer competition**

25 Day 2 we went to the north shores of Oahu and watched and surfer competition and pretty
much hung out on the beach. **Pic #0015**. She played and splashed around a little in knee

1 deep water and we talked about how big and far the ocean is. I showed her a map of where
2 we were on my phone. I think she got the gravity of the distance when she said, "Wow"
3 looking out in the endless-looking Pacific.
