EDUCATION TYPE	VIRGINIA AIR NATIONAL GUARD
CCAF - Community College of the Air Force	 BMT and Technical Training award regionally accredited college credits towards CCAF Associate's Degree Additional general education requirements may be met from local/online college courses
TA - Tuition Assistance (VANGSTAP)	 Up to \$10,000 per semester and \$20,000 cap per fiscal year. *<i>school must have a physical location in VA</i> Funding can be used for 1 Associates, 1 Bachelors, 1 Masters and 1 Doctorate Degree
Post 9/11 GI Bill	 Eligible for 40-100% of total GI Bill benefit after 90 consecutive active-duty days supporting contingency operations. If 3+ years served in support of contingency operations, then eligible for total benefit.
Montgomery GI Bill	 Eligible immediately after completion of technical training. No member contribution required. \$466 per month for full time (ch.1606)

• Extra \$350 per month if in critical AFSC

SERVICE

VIRGINIA AIR NATIONAL GUARD

4 or 6 year initial enlistment

Retirement eligibility determined on points accrued after 20 years of service. Benefits begin paying at 60 years old. May be sooner with qualifying Title 10 Activation time

Retirement Plan is 40% of your base pay at 20 years of your retiring rank. Add 2.5% percent for every 2 years of service after 20.

Basic Military Training	7 1/2 weeks at Lackland AFB, TX
Technical Training	6 weeks to 18 months Location and duration are dependent on Air Force Specialty
Airman Leadership School	May complete either 5 week in-residence course OR Self-paced distance learning
NCO Academy	May complete either 6 week in-residence course OR Self-paced distance learning

TRAVEL

TRAVEL TYPE	VIRGINIA AIR NATIONAL GUARD
TDY (Temporary Duty)	Business-like trips with lodging paid and per diem given for food and incidentals
HOPS (Help Our People Save)	Free or low-cost stand-by flights on military aircraft for military members and family
STATE & NATIONAL PARKS	Free access to State and National Parks
