RE: Alaska Scaffolding & Shoring Agreement – August 2024 Re-Allocation & September 2024 Allocation

Dear Contractor:

Pursuant to the 2022-2025 Alaska Scaffolding and Shoring Master Agreement, there is a re-allocation of funds (effective August 1, 2024) and a \$2.25 increase effective September 1, 2024. The re-allocation and allocation are as follows:
