To take free ESL classes, you must:

- ✓ Live in Illinois.
- ✓ Be at least 18 years old.
 - 16 and 17-year-old students can take classes if you submit a high school release form from your former high school. Please talk to staff at City Colleges if you have never attended school in the United States.
- ✗ Students do **not** need to have a Social Security number.
- ✗ Students **cannot** have a F1, F2, J1, or J2 visa.
