CONCEPT OF OPERATIONS

SCENARIO: This range requires the Soldier to move and engage single and multiple targets at various times, positions, and distances using the fundamentals of quick fire to qualify on their weapon. It is HIGHLY encouraged that shooters utilize the EST at the Training Support Center to practice shooting fundamentals. Pistols will be available on the range and soldiers are responsible for cleaning their weapon (if assigned one) prior to turn in. BLUF: The Headquarters Support Company will run a GAFPB/Schützenschnur range a CR-1 on 28JUNE22 IAW 3-22.9 and 3-22.249 IOT provide personnel the opportunity to qualify for the event. On 280730JUNE22, OIC will sign for CR2. The Range will be occupied, inspected, setup, and go HOT NLT 0830. Transportation will be coordinated by each Unit. Firers will arrive and will be given a Safety Brief, Orientation, and Walk Through of the event standard and scoring. OIC will conduct ongoing status report to S3 and Company Commander. Events will be run until ammo/daylight runs out or everyone is complete. Reports will be collected for the final scoring same day. Range closeout report will be turned into BN S3 NLT 281900JUNE22.

WEAPONS QUALIFICATION

Candidates must achieve **ONE** weapons qualification (Pistol or Rifle) of the German Marksmanship Qualification (Schuetzenschnur) for the GAFPB.

If both qualifications are passed, the higher result will be rated.

In order to obtain the "Schuetzenschnur" **BOTH**, Rifle & Pistol must be shot and passed.

The <u>lowest achievement indicates</u> the <u>overall result for</u> Gold, <u>Silver or Bronce</u>.

e. g. Pistol → Bronce and Rifle → Gold = BRONCE

Pistol Qualification

<u>P-S-2</u>

Pistol

- Distance to target 25m
- 5 rounds
- 3 targets
- First shot is not cocked (hammer cocked / double action)

Scoring

Bronce: each target hit with one round (3)
Silver: each target hit with one round + 1 (4)
Gold: each target hit with one round + 2 (5)

Prequisite: EACH target must be hit!
