EDGE POLISHING GUIDELINES

How to Polish Countertop Edges with Using Diamond Polishing Pads

• These slabs can have their edges polished on site into a smooth, bullnose or finished edge with a polish that not matches the top of the tile.

 Place the Slab tile on a work table, and clamp it secured to ensure it doesn't move while grinding or polishing.



Backing pad

- Carefully look on the slab edges. Smaller grid sizes (50, 100, 200) fine grinding & smoothness.
- Higher grid sizes (1500, 3000) are suitable to achieve shiny finishing.



Attach Polishing Pads & Backing Pads to Wet Polisher, Start Polishing.

- Attach the backing pads to wet polisher, ensure it is switched off before attaching it.
- Now you can begin the polishing process, open the diamond polishing kit and start with grit 50 or 100 polishing pad.
- Use the grinder initially as low speed and as needed increase its speed slowly for faster polishing suitable for specific stone.
- Review polishing finish before moving to next grid
- Make sure that you have used grids from lower to higher, apply gradually all the grids 50, 100, 200, 400, 800, 1500 and 3000 grids.
- Don't use more than the double grids from the first diamond polishing pads.
- Maintain the regularity to using the polishing pads.



Follow All Step Correctly, Here Is Your Polished Slab

- Use one by one pad until the polish starts to shine accurately.
- You would find good shine at grit 1000, and as you progress to grit 1500 and 3000 it will start getting mirror like finish.
