

## Post IV Thrombolytic Therapy Monitoring Checklist: Low-Intensity Monitoring

**Policy ID 12773764, Section 5:** Every 15 minutes for 2 hours, every 2 hours for 8 hours, and then every 4 hours from the time of bolus. \*NIH Stroke Scale should be done 90-120 mins post-bolus to determine low-intensity eligibility, upon admission to inpatient unit, with neuro exam decline and 24 hours post bolus

### IV Thrombolytic Administration Time:

Vitals and Neuros to be assessed Q15min for 2 hours prior to transfer to in-patient unit  
 Q2h monitoring to start 2 hours after bolus dose administration

If 90-120min NIHSS is <10 and patient is deemed medically stable, proceed with Low Intensity Monitoring per order
