

Monday's structure fire leaves one dead, one injured

A fire in a recreational structure early Monday morning resulted in one death, as well as injury to one first responder, officials said.

"Around 1 a.m., the Lampasas Fire Department responded to a structure fire in the 1700 block of East Avenue G," Lampasas Fire Marshal JP Harris said. "The first emergency personnel arrived on scene at 12:53 a.m."

One fire engine, two command vehicles, two deputy chiefs, one fire rescue vehicle, one squad and two ambulances were present at the scene.

Investigation of the fire has been completed by members of the Lampasas Fire Department and the Texas Fire Marshal's Office. According to Harris, this incident will remain open until reports are received from the medical examiner.

At press time, the name of the victim had not been released.
