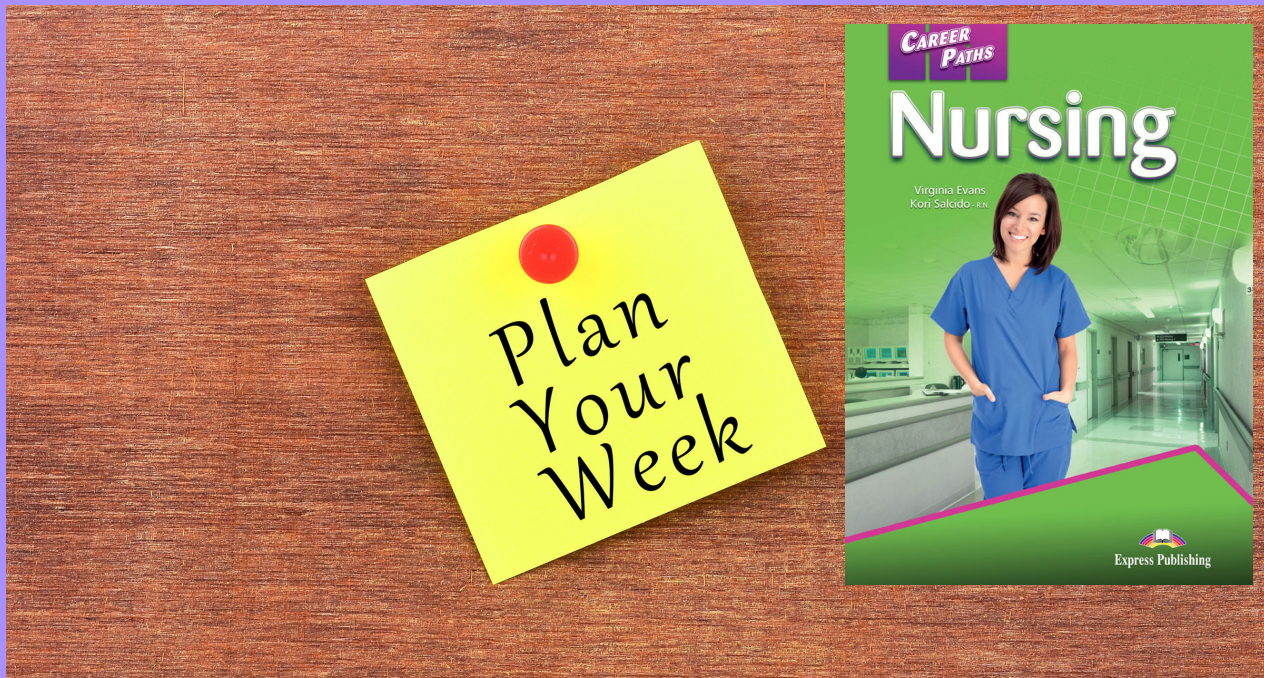

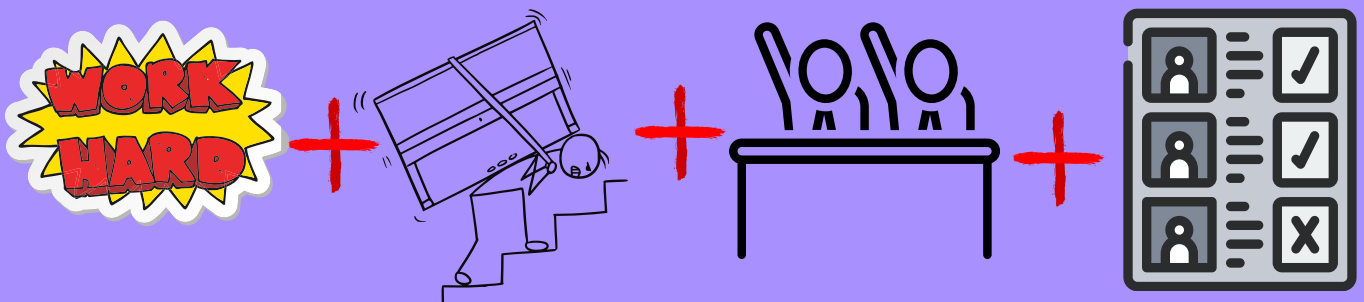
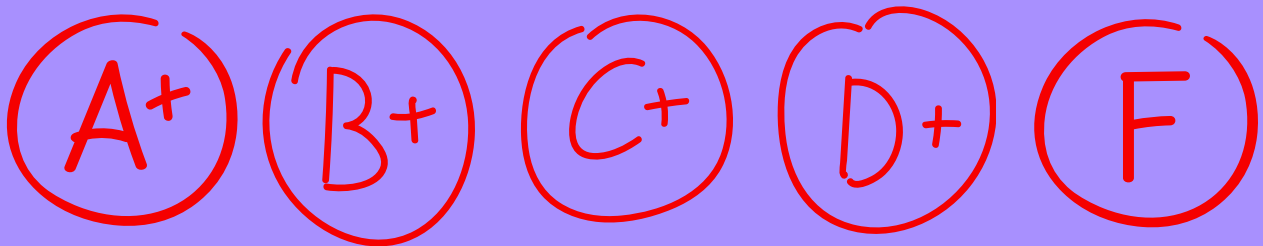

Grading and Complaint Week

1. **Complaint week!** Please take this under advisement. I will rate you based on your work on LMS and the classroom. Just remember, the CURVE is the final mark of the system. Those are school policies.
2. Use your mobile phone solely for the dictionary or apps we use in our classroom. Never KakaoTalk or Facebook.
3. Pay attention to your professor.
4. Listen respectfully while the professor or other students speak. Take part and use English in the classroom. If your teacher asks you a question, try to respond.
5. Bring your textbook, pen and paper to the class daily.
6. Complete all your assignments before the beginning of the course each day. Attendance (20%)
7. It's Woosong College policy that you are present at each class. If you cannot attend, your final grade will be reduced. If you are late for class 3 times, this will count as a miss. Note: If you are absent, you MUST speak to your Departmental Assistant. Absences may be excused and absences from class may be compensated with a doctor's note or a formal written apology from a professional (teachers, doctors, lawyers, principals).
8. Mid-course presentation (20%) and final exam (40%) There are two exams scheduled for this course: a mid-course presentation and a final exam. Your midterm presentation will be a group presentation (3 to 4 students) for 3 to 5 minutes. Your talk will focus on MY GLOBAL LIFE: HERE OR ABROAD. Your presentation should be informative and interesting, but should not include any role-playing or long pre-recorded English material (less than 10%). The strongest Midterm Presentations, in each department can participate in the Woosong College English Contest, at the end of the semester for a chance to win cash prizes or a trip abroad (if the pandemic is over)!
9. Your Final Exam will be a written in-class exam given on the final day of class.
