## Print out the petitions and collect signatures

Petitions are one way of making our voice heard by elected representatives. Hardcopy petitions have much more power than online petitions because they feature a citizen's original signature. Every signature collected gives the petition more power. One petition is to get rid of SOGI 123. The other petition is to get rid of one of the most ardent supporters of SOGI 123: Prime Minister Justin Trudeau.

To support our current petition campaign, follow the steps below:

**Step 1:** Go to https://www.flowcode.com/page/AllFiredUpForFreedom

Step 2: Print out several copies of both petitions

Step 3: Collect as many signatures as possible between now and November 8.

**Step 4:** Hand in the completed petitions to Benita Pedersen on or before November 9. Coordinate a meeting with her by calling or texting 1-780-349-0181 or emailing PedersenBenita@gmail.com

**Step 5:** On Friday, November 10, Benita meets with Member of Parliament Arnold Viersen and presents the #TrudeauMustGo petition.

Step 6: On Tuesday, November 14, Benita meets with the Chief of Staff for Alberta's Minister of Education and presents the Stop SOGI Now petition
