DESCRIPTION OF SCHOOL

An independent college preparatory day school for grades seven through twelve, Harvard-Westlake School is the result of a merger between the Harvard School (for boys) founded in 1900 and the Westlake School for Girls established in 1904. Harvard-Westlake School draws its student body from the diverse communities of Los Angeles County and is located on two campuses: the Middle School, serving grades seven through nine, is located in Los Angeles; the Upper School, with grades ten through twelve, is located in Studio City. The school is accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges.

REMOTE LEARNING GRADING POLICY

When Harvard-Westlake moved to remote learning in March 2020, in response to the COVID pandemic, we determined that, because students had completed three of four academic quarters and because our year-long grades are cumulative, teachers would be able to issue year-end letter grades that reflected their students' accomplishments. Students returned to full-day, in-person learning in August 2021.

HONORS AND ADVANCED PLACEMENT PROGRAM

Harvard-Westlake offers 2 Advanced courses (within the Mathematics Department), 29 Honors courses, and 25 Advanced Placement courses. Advanced, Honors and AP designations all denote high-rigor courses that require departmental approval. Some departments offer post-AP courses that are considered honors courses (see below). Beginning with the Class of 2022, there are AP maximums designed to encourage students toward a healthy workload balance and toward our wide variety of elective course options. Tenth graders my take up to 2 AP courses, eleventh graders may take no more than 3 AP courses, and twelfth graders may take no more than 4 AP courses.

POST-AP COURSES

The following is a list of courses that students can take after completing AP courses in some departments; these courses are honors-level classes: Honors Senior English Seminar (AP Literature or AP Language are co-requisites), Post-AP Spanish Seminar, Honors Post-AP Chinese Literature and Culture, Honors French Literature and Arts, Honors Latin Literature, Multivariable Calculus, Linear Algebra, Honors Design and Data Structures, and Honors Topics in Computer Science.

SPECIAL COURSE OFFERINGS

Senior Independent Study allows seniors and faculty mentors an opportunity to work together in an area of common interest. Independent study projects are designed by students; the projects are evaluated by the faculty mentors and a faculty/administrative committee

Directed Study courses allow students the opportunity to explore topics beyond our standard curricular offerings through courses that meet twice per cycle and highlight various areas of expertise within our teaching faculty.

Several courses are offered through our Kutler Center for Interdisciplinary Studies and **Independent Research.** These courses offer students opportunities for research, in-depth study, and immersion across disciplines and beyond those available in traditional offerings.

SEMESTER- AND YEAR-AWAY PROGRAMS

Harvard-Westlake students may study in France, Spain, China, and Italy with the School Year Abroad Program, in Vermont at Mountain School, in Maine at the Maine Coast Semester, in Washington DC at the School for Ethics and Global Leadership, or in Colorado at High Mountain Institute.

DISCIPLINARY REPORTING POLICY

Harvard-Westlake reports major disciplinary measures taken against a student to any college, university, scholarship program or educational program that requests such information. Harvard-Westlake will report this information at the time of application. Major disciplinary measures include, but are not limited to, suspensions and expulsions occurring while the student is enrolled in grades nine through twelve. When such measures have been taken against a student after an initial application has been sent, Harvard-Westlake will send updated information reflecting this change in the student's status.


