It contains poetry and short stories by Zahra Linsky and features illustrations by Carmen Devine and Tenza Nazur:

- "Below the Greenhouse," accompanied by the poem "Follow the Forest," is a short story about an undead wolf-deer and the girls it chases into the empty depths of a greenhouse.
- Accompanied by "A Quiet Paradise," two girls and their dog spend their final spring break of high school searching for Bigfoot in "Bigfoot Hunting."
- In "Godskin," a young woman refuses to become the prophet of the sea god, Ransmal. It is accompanied by "Rocky Gardens."
- Rumors become reality in the Frisian-inspired mountain town of Baarda in "That Which Spreads." Following the dares of her friends, a girl faces the deathless creature who waits inside the forest with his carnivorous deer. It is accompanied by the poem "Ruins."
