HOW WE QUALIFY FOR MEDICAL INSURANCE

360 HRS. WORK IN MONTHS OF:	QUALIFIES YOU FOR COVERAGE DURING:
JAN., FEB., MAR.	MAY, JUNE, JULY
APRIL, MAY, JUNE	AUG., SEPT., OCT.
JULY, AUG., SEPT.	NOV., DEC., JAN.
OCT., NOV., DEC.	FEB., MAR., APRIL

Remember to inform Local or Trust Fund Office of any time off due to disability within 90 days, current members may qualify for extra benefits.

If you work more than 360 hours during a Work Quarter, the excess hours will be credited to a "Reserve Account" established for you, up to a maximum of 720 hours. You will be eligible during an Eligibility Quarter whenever the hours worked by you (if any) in the preceding Work Quarter, plus the hours in your Reserve Account, total at least 360 hours.

The number of work hours required for initial eligibility by participants that have never been covered will be 300 hours in a work quarter. After initial eligibility has been established, the work hour requirement will revert to the normal 360 hours for any subsequent eligibility quarter.
