

Recruiting Process

1. Fill out the pre-qualification sheet on the website. I will be in contact with you as soon as I can.
2. I will let you know if you're qualified, and we will set up an appointment to talk.
3. At your appointment, I will get to know you better and answer any questions you might have. If you're still interested in joining the team, we will fill out some paperwork and I will send you home with an additional application.
4. Once I have received your application and the necessary documents, we will schedule a MEPS (Military Entrance Processing Stations) appointment and ASVAB test date. I will see you one to two days prior to explain what MEPS is and answer all of your questions.
5. On the first day at MEPS, it is likely you will take the ASVAB and other tests before returning to your hotel. The next morning, you will undergo a physical exam. Once completed, you will head back home and officially be entered into the Delayed Entry Program (DEP).
6. Once in DEP, you will participate in physical and mental training that will prepare you to become a member of the Special Warfare Team. You will be working with special warfare members to help you become a better athlete.
7. Once you are ready physically and mentally, we can then book you a job and get you a date for basic military training.
8. You finally made it! You will do a final check up at MEPS before officially swearing into the Air Force. You will be on your way to San Antonio, Texas to start your amazing career as a Special Warfare Airman.
