MEN AREN'T VICTIMS



- DV does not discriminate
- Men do experience domestic abuse
- Men report less
- Reasons they remain silent
 - Embarrassment/ shame
 - Think no one will believe them
 - Commons beliefs about gender roles

ABUSERS ARE KICKED OUT OF THE ARMY

- This is a possibility
- NOT TRUE for most cases
- Reporting allows:
 - Safety
 - Accountability
 - Treatment



ADVOCATES ONLY HELP IF YOU WANT TO LEAVE

- Advocates offer support, information and resources regardless of ones choice
- The Advocate's focus is on increasing safety and strengthening relationships

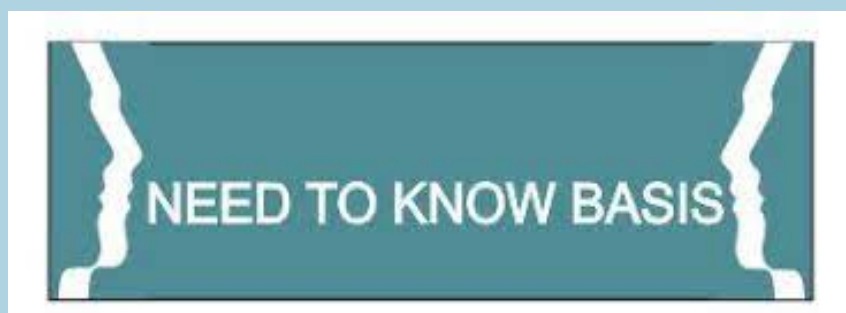


THE ARMY DOES NOTHING TO SUPPORT VICTIMS

- FAP is regulated by DoD, DA, and follows State Laws and Local Policy
- Each Installation has a policy on family violence
- Each installation has a Victim Advocate Program
- Two Domestic Abuse Reporting Options are available
