



Thank you for choosing Legion Memorial Golf Course. Please observe the following standards of etiquette to foster an environment conducive to the enjoyment of the day's activity.

Dress Code- Participants must wear proper golf attire. Golf Shoes or Tennis shoes must be worn on the golf course or in the clubhouse. Shirts must remain on at all times. Cut-offs, muscle shirts, track pants, tank tops, basketball shorts, or jerseys are not acceptable.

Alcohol Policy- Washington State Liquor Law and Everett City ordinance #2626-02 forbids players from bringing their own alcoholic beverages upon the premises. All liquor must be purchased at the Legion Memorial Greenside Grill or from the golf course beverage cart. All purchases must be consumed on premises by order of the Washington State Liquor Control Board.

Any players bringing their own alcohol will have it confiscated and may be requested to leave the premises without any refund. Legion Memorial staff has the right to stop serving any individual or group in order for us to serve responsibly and insure the safety of all our customers and employees. Your tournament chairperson has read and agreed to our alcohol policy.

Conduct- Legion Memorial has zero tolerance for any violent behavior or offensive language.

Participants- Each player must have their own set of clubs. Groups may not consist of more than four people without prior authorization from the pro shop.

Slow Play- The Pace of Play Goal is a 4 hour to 4 ½ hour maximum round. We also define slow play as more than 1 ½ shots behind the group ahead of you. We encourage you to keep up with the group in front of you. If you fall behind, we will give you one hole to move back within 1½ shots of the group in front of you. If you do not catch up, we may ask you to pick up your golf balls and go forward to catch up.

Player Assistant- On course Player Assistants will be monitoring play. They are present to assist everyone in having an enjoyable day. Please follow their directions.

Power Carts- Cart waivers must be signed by the participants for liability for injuries or damages beyond normal wear and tear. Daily cart rules will be posted on the carts and announced by the starter. When carts are not restricted to the paths, the carts must return to the cart paths from 30 feet short of the green until 30 feet beyond the next tee.

Etiquette- Thank you for repairing ball marks, repairing divots and raking sand bunkers.
