

JACKSONVILLE RECYCLING GUIDELINES

City of Jacksonville NO longer accepts Plastic Bags in the Recycling. Material must be placed loose in the container.

NO BAGS!! Items in a bag will be considered TRASH

We accept the following in containers marked:

"Paper – Plastic – Glass – Aluminum"

- Aluminum (cans, foil, & pie pans)
- Plastic containers 1-3, 5 & 7 (bottles, food containers, etc.)
- Steel (tin) cans
- Glass
- Newspaper
- Phonebooks
- Magazines
- Office Paper
- Junk Mail
- Catalogs
- Paper Board (Cereal & Shoe Boxes, Notepad Backing*)

We DO NOT Accept:

PLASTIC BAGS, TRASH BAGS, GROCERY STORE BAGS.

Hello Fresh Boxes, Pizza Boxes, Dog waste, Polystyrene or Styrofoam, (i.e. Packing Material, Egg Cartons, Styrofoam Food Trays), Rubber Gloves, Light Bulbs, Electronic Devices, Clothing, Mirrors, Household Garbage, any items having contained Chlorine, Paint, Pesticides, Acid, Motor Oil or any Hazardous Materials, Waxed Paper Products, Photos, Film Carbon Paper, or Baby Diapers.
