Introduction To Derryvolgie Hall

We opened in 1995, Derryvolgie Hall is a purpose built complex providing self-catering accommodation for students and young people working in Belfast. Located at the Malone Road end of Derryvolgie Avenue, it is within a few minutes walking distance of Queen's University. It is under the management of the Presbyterian Church in Ireland, and is a community with a distinctly Christian ethos.



Derryvolgie Hall is made up of 3 blocks, each having 3 flats of 9 or 10 single study bedrooms. All bedrooms are attractively furnished with hand basin, wardrobe and study desk. Each flat also has its own kitchen and dining area, as well as toilet and shower facilities. Residents must provide their own bed linen, kitchen utensils and cutlery, etc. Included in the price is the use of a launderette, a comfortable TV room, and a recreation room.

SUBWARDENS & INTERNS

A sub warden lives in each block. These look after security and fire safety in the building. The property is locked each night by the Sub Wardens. We have 30 car parking spaces which operate on a first come first served basis. Cars must be parked on Derryvolgie Avenue when the car park is full. Students who bring their cars, do so at their own risk.

There are resident interns who live in the hall and co-ordinate weekly girls and guys' Bible studies, prayer meetings and various ministry programmes - as well as making all the fun stuff happen throughout the year!

Derryvolgie Hall is much more than a hall of residence and as a result we expect our residents to get involved in the full spectrum of what community life is all about. Cost & Conditions

The cost of staying at Derryvolgie Hall 2025-2026 is £120 per week and fees must be paid over any holidays. Students are billed on a termly basis to coincide with grants and are expected to remain with us for the full academic year. If requested, monthly payments can be arranged. Please contact Vicky in the office about all payment queries.

Please be advised that financial assistance is available to students from low income families. For further information please contact the office.

A £300 deposit is required to guarantee your place. £250 of this is returnable at the end of your stay, but may be used to cover any damage caused by you, or extraordinary costs attributed to you, such as fines. Residents are also required to sign a License Agreement and have a Guarantor.



How do I apply?

Application forms are completed through a Google form. We encourage all applicants to fill out the form with as much information as possible.
