

FREE 14 WEEK CONSTRUCTION SKILLS TRAINING PROGRAM

Learn basic and advanced construction techniques, including OSHA certifications and transitional employment. This program is designed to prepare participants for union trade apprenticeships and jobs in the construction industry.

Skills Training:

- **Carpentry (Basic & Advanced):** Gain knowledge of basic carpentry concepts and functions, such as measure, cut and fasten. Students also learn the concept of structural integrity in buildings, blueprint reading, and carpentry terminology.
- **Plumbing (Basic & Advanced):** Gain knowledge of basic plumbing theory and practice, supply and drain, waste and vent systems (DWV). Students will also learn plumbing terminology.
- **Electrical (Basic & Advanced):** Gain knowledge of basic electrical theory and practice, including conduit pipe bending and installation; hot, neutral and ground wires; Wire fishing; circuit panel parts and installation. switches, outlets and finish unit hook-ups and installations; Amps and current, voltage and watts usage, and electrical terminology.

Credential:

- **OSHA 10 Safety Certification:** Qualified to recognize and avoid hazards in construction environments.

Foundational Knowledge:

- **Foundational Math:** Build a strong foundation in math skills necessary for carpentry, plumbing, and electrical work (e.g., measurements, and calculations).
