BMT Pre-Arrival



737 TRG

- Anything not manufacturer labeled will get thrown away during initial inspection i.e. shampoo, soap, lotion, etc.
- Bring serviceable gym shoes, trainees should be prepared to walk multiple miles upon arrival
- New reporting statement “Sergeant, trainee/guardian _____ reports as ordered.” Trainees will say sergeant until the full rank is learned.

Current BMT operations



737 TRG

- Initial contact is made to family by trainee within 72 hours of arriving at BMT. (If the family doesn't hear from them, the trainee probably called someone else.)
- Air and Space Force Basic Military Training consists of **7.5** weeks
- Trainees will be administered the COVID vaccine while in BMT if not already vaccinated in 0 & 3 WOT-mandated per DoD guidance
- Trainees **MUST** have hard copies of important documentation to include original COVID-19 Vaccine card.
 - COVID-19 testing will only be completed if trainee is showing symptoms upon arrival to BMT

- 1st WOT – Gait training to help improve form & cadence, Initial PT assessment
- 2nd WOT – War Skills Military Studies (WSMS) classes, weapons procedures application, and drill application, 1st and 2nd Clothing Issue (combined)
- 3rd WOT – Career Guidance, PT assessment
- 4th WOT – Sensitive Skills appointments, War Skills Military Studies (WSMS) classes, flight/individual photos, Recruit Living Area (RLA) Appraisals
- 5th WOT – Blues week, second haircut, final PT assessment, BMT progress checks (Drill, D&A, RLA, etc.) Tactical Combat Casualty Care (TCCC) and Foundational Expeditionary Skills Training (FEST) will be taught

Current BMT operations cont...



737 TRG

- 6th WOT – **BEAST** (Changed to 2 days and includes CATM and CBRN) followed by End of Course exam upon return and Blood Donors, dog tag ceremony at culmex
- 7th WOT – **Graduation**. Complete RAND Survey, medical processing, traffic safety brief, 2nd Boot Issue (Steel-toe boot) as required by AFSC, computer based training/AF portal login, and individual photo pick-up
- Airman's Run/Retreat – Wednesday (Followed by town pass until 1800hrs)
- Graduation Ceremony Parade – Thursday (Followed by Base Liberty. Honor Grads are allowed town pass this day)
- Graduates will receive phones before the ceremony
- Shipping – Friday

- VARL names are limited to 6, however additional DoD cardholders may attend.
- Vaccinations are NOT mandatory for visitors.

How can recruiters better prepare recruits?



Packing

737 TRG

- Pack enough undergarments for 1 week (socks, underwear, bras, etc.)
- Pack enough toiletries for 2 weeks (bottle soap, shampoo, toothpaste, shaving equipment)
- Pack at least 3 changes of **appropriate attire**... Keep in mind the time of year. Summer is hot (shorts/t-shirts), winter is cold (jeans/long sleeve shirt). During winter months, fleeces and watch caps will be issued.
- Female hair regulations have changed, ensure they have the correct product for hair type

Packing

737 TRG

- Do not have your recruit over pack. Do not bring laptops, tablets, gaming consoles, or any type of high value electronics. One large backpack or gym bag is sufficient. They will only be able to bring **three (3) bags** total with them to technical school. Issued a backpack and duffel bag in BMT
- While in BMT, trainees are currently provided weekly phone calls. **Do not cancel phone service.**
- Ensure recruits bring social security card and Driver's license with all important paperwork (marriage certificates, college transcripts, actual COVID-19 Vaccination card, etc.)

How can recruiters better prepare recruits?

Finances and Education

- Set up autopay for bills, power of attorney, etc. think of it like a Pre-Deployment Checklist.
- Bring minimal cash, debit card is best, however not accepted at Clipper Cuts.
- Trainees should have bank account already set up
- ANG trainees should ensure orders are correct prior to arrival at BMT
- Trainees receiving college credit towards rank will need to bring college transcripts

How can recruiters better prepare recruits?



Physical Training

737 TRG

- Trainees should be in basic physical shape. The PT program is designed to enhance current performance but not intended take them from 0 – 100.
 - Unprepared trainees are more likely to sustain injuries
- BMT is very physical and trainees will can take 30K plus steps per day.
- Keep in mind the time of year they will be here and have them get acclimated to hydrating appropriately.

How can recruiters better prepare recruits? Religious Services

- Religious Accommodations need to be routed and approved at the recruiting level we cannot do this at BMT (i.e. beards for religious purposes, headgear, etc). At BMT we do check for waivers regarding this and if they do not have the appropriate approvals, accommodations cannot be made.
- Religious services have resumed normal operations for the following services: Catholic, Contemporary, Jewish, Liturgical Protestant, Islamic, Orthodox with more services to resume normal operations soon.

Miscellaneous

- Don't encourage recruits to "fly under the radar."
- Security clearances should be initiated prior to arrival at BMT.
- Bring hard copies of VARLs. BMT personnel cannot access ones submitted via "system" by Recruiters

WINGMAN/TEAMMATE POLICY

The wingman/teammate policy establishes the pairing of 737 TRG Trainees/Guardians into teams to teach **teamwork**, develop a sense of **responsibility** and **accountability** for fellow Airmen/Guardians. The policy improves safety during BMT and reduces the likelihood and opportunity for sexual harassment, misconduct, suicidal gestures/attempts and overall health and wellness.

HYDRATION SCHEDULE:

Trainees should drink
 3/4 to 1 water bottle per hour not
 to exceed:
 2 water bottles per hour or
 16 water bottles a day

IF YOU FIND YOURSELF ALONE:

- Locate ANY Trainee/Guardian of same gender
 - Contact CQ / Find an instructor ASAP
- Trainees/Guardians separated from their wingman/teammate **have an obligation** to report the incident to their MTIs, CQ, SC or Flight/CCs
