

LEGALIZED WHATEVERY PARENT SHOULD KNOW

WHAT'S LEGAL?

Adults, 21 years and older can use cannabis anywhere that smoking tobacco is permitted, except in a motor vehicle, or where the Clean Air Act is in effect. Allows possession of up to 3 oz. of flower buds and leaf - 5lbs of leaf at your home - 24 grams on concentrate on your person.





WHAT'S NOT LEGAL?

It is still against the law for people younger than 21 years old to possess, sell or use any amount of cannabis. It is illegal to drive while under the influence or impaired by cannabis.

DOES THAT MEAN I CAN BUY ADULT-USE MARIJUANA

LOCALLY NOW? NO. The Town of Oyster Bay, the City of Glen Cove AND the Village of Sea Cliff all opted-out of retail sale of marijuana as of the end of 2021, so there are no LEGAL retail sales of marijuana in the immediate area of the North Shore School District.

WHAT ABOUT FLAVORED VAPES? ARE THEY LEGAL?

NO! NYS Law prohibits the sale of flavored nicotine vaping products, including menthol, in an effort to limit the product's appeal to youth and young adults.



DELTA-8 & DELTA-10... ARE THEY LEGAL?

NO. THEY ARE NOT LEGAL.

Delta-8 & Delta 10 THC have psychoactive and intoxicating effects, similar to delta-9 THC (i.e., the component responsible for the "high" people may experience from using cannabis). Consumers should be aware that Delta-8 & Delta-10 THC products have not been evaluated or approved by the FDA for safe use in any context.

TALK TO YOUR KIDS!!

I AM WORRIED ABOUT HOW MARIJUANA PRODUCTS CAN BE MARKETED TO KIDS. WHAT DOES THE LAW SAY?

- NY law mandates that cannabis products cannot be made attractive to or target persons under 21.
 - No bubble or cartoon font, neon colors, cartoons or animations on packaging
 - May not promote or depict overconsumption
 - Cannot utilize similarities to products or words that refer to products that are used by teens, including any imitation of food, candy, soda, drinks or cereals.
