At least 18 years of age.

Pass a physical, background check and drug test.

Possess a valid Oregon Drivers License with good driving record.

Requirements of Emergency Response Volunteers

- Attend Academy
- Give full attention to learning and improving capabilities
- Attend 75% of weekly drills

Drills are held one night a week from 7pm to 9pm. and some Saturdays. Training focusses on fire-fighting, EMS, hazardous materials and wildland fire operations.
