

- Once opening remarks and safety brief have concluded, all guidance will come from 2LT McCray and Lifeguards.



- Soldier will swim 100 meters without external support (for staying afloat) with a timed minimum of 4 minutes to complete.
- Once the 4 minutes has elapsed, Soldier will remove both ACU trousers and ACU jacket without holding on to the poolside.
