How do I qualify?

- Must be a California Resident or AB540 eligible
- Enrolled as a full time student (12 units or more)
- Have earned fewer than 30 degree applicable units
- Qualify for the CCPG (California College Promise Grant Method A or B)
- Be educationally disadvantaged as defined by Title 5
